### **Gemalte Diagramme. Bauhaus, Kunst und Infografik (Painted diagrams. Bauhaus, art and infographics)**

On Saturday, 30 March 2019, Museum für Konkrete Kunst, together with Stiftung für Konkrete Kunst und Design, will open the new exhibition Gemalte Diagramme. Bauhaus, Kunst und Infografik (Painted diagrams. Bauhaus, art and infographics) from 7 p.m. onwards. This gives us two reasons to celebrate, as the MKK is not only celebrating the centenary the Bauhaus but also the tenth edition of the Art and Beat Party in Ingolstadt.

### **Gemalte Diagramme. Bauhaus, Kunst und Infografik**

The exhibition Gemalte Diagramme. Bauhaus, Kunst und Infografik reveals the astounding interaction between infographics and art, the beginnings of which are found in the Bauhaus and its surrounding milieu with a legacy that continues to the present day. Starting from its historical origins, the MKK explores the theme right up until today, examining the connection between the two areas in this exhibition that focuses particularly on contemporary art.

The exhibit shows works by around 30 international male and female artists, demonstrating how the visual arts use diagrams on a semantic and/or aesthetic level in subversive, ironic or affirmative ways. In addition, the exhibition also presents the rich repertoire of artistic compositional methods that are used by graphic artists. Interactive stations and digital presentations positioned between the works of art allow the visitor to actively grasp the exhibition's themes.

With this unique exhibition held during the Bauhaus centennial year, the MKK succeeded in obtaining the enthusiastic support of a high-calibre jury of the German Federal Cultural Foundation. The exhibition Gemalte Diagramme is one of a total of 23 projects that the Federal Cultural Foundation is supporting with a total of 4.2 million euros from the Bauhaus Today Fund. In addition to numerous other projects, the exhibition Gemalte Diagramme is part of the Germany-wide anniversary programme bauhaus100 and represents one of the milestone projects in Bavaria.

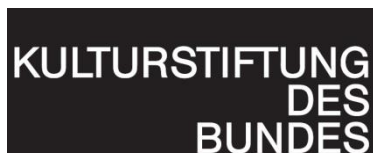
### **Catalogue**

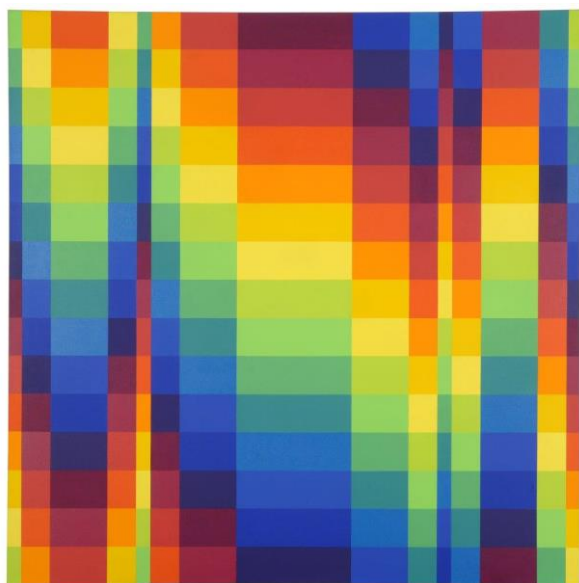

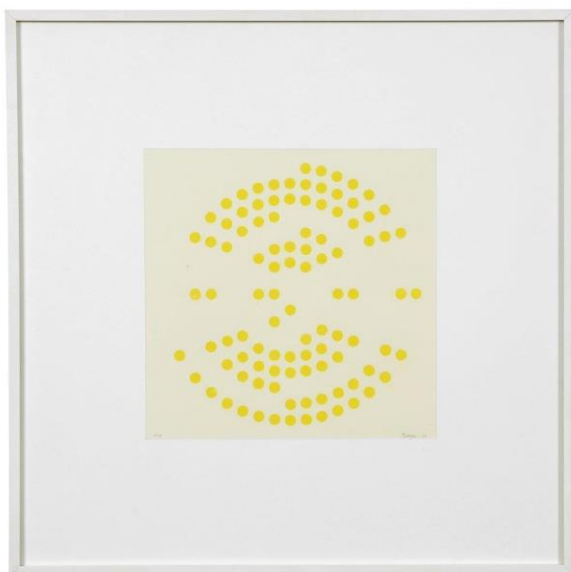

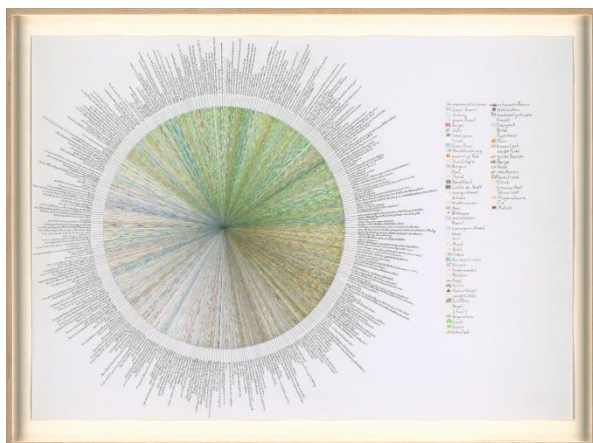
